Beginning Your Journey With Free Motion Quilting – In this class you will learn fun and easy designs that will allow you to start finishing your own quilt tops. I will show you overall designs plus designs that will work in blocks, triangles, and borders. You will leave this class with a multitude of designs and ideas on how to start your journey in free motion quilting.

Beyond the Basics – Intermediate I Free Motion Quilting – If you have beginner's experience with free motion quilting then it's time to learn some more designs to make your quilt tops come to life. You will leave this class with fun designs and also ways to change up basic designs to give them more zing! We will also discuss how batting choice and thread choice play a part in your quilting.

Feathers in Free Motion!! – In this class you will learn the ins and outs of feathers. Learn how there are many feather designs and how to quilt them. Feathers are such a favorite of so many and there are so many different types of feathers to learn!! This is always a fun class. Previous Free motion experience is needed for this class.

<u>Quilts Rule....with Ruler Work!</u> Learn a great technique to take your free motion quilting to the next level by adding ruler work. Learn how to use long arm rulers....whether on a long arm machine or a domestic machine (**requires free motion ruler foot**). Learn the steps to get perfect designs and precision that comes with using rulers and then learn different techniques to make those designs stand out!

Elements of Change – Let me show you how to take easy quilting designs and by adding or changing something about it making it into a fun and new design. This is a really fun class and lends to a lot of creativity and thinking outside of the box.

<u>World of Swirls</u> – Swirls are such a fun and versatile design to use when quilting. Let us delve into all the different variations we can think of to learn new and fun designs!! This is a fun class where we can expand our creativity.

Beyond the Stencil – Let me show you how to take a normal quilt stencil and change it up into ways that you would have never dreamed of. This is definitely a class to make you be more creative in your quilting. Lots of tips and tricks will be shared in this class.

<u>Quilting the Dream!!</u> – Have you seen the Dream Big panels and thought how much fun it would be to quilt your own? Let me share my tips and tricks for these fun panels. I have quilted numerous panels and have lots of ideas to share with you. We will take one quarter of a panel to quilt during class. Once you have that done, you will be set for going home and quilting a full size panel!! Supply list and kit fee. This is a 3-4 hour hands on class.
