Piecing Notes

Please use 1/4" seam allowance.


Fabrics should all be sewn with right sides together.


<u>NOTE:</u> Tumbler blocks in pictures are all the same color, however, since piecing is happening in columns, yours will be different colors within each column to reflect your color choices for your tumbler "waves".

I found it easier to lay all of my tumbler blocks out, prior to piecing, to make sure I had my color placement correct.



Place one tumbler and one strip right sides together.







Sew strip to one side of each tumbler shape. See Tumbler Block/Sashing Assembly Chart below!!

Then press open.

NOTE: On the first and last row of tumblers, you will need to sew a strip to both sides of the tumbler.





Placing your ruler even with the top of the tumbler (strip on right side), trim off extra of the background strips.

Repeat the process by aligning the ruler with the bottom of the tumbler/ strip block.

You should now have a tumbler/strip block that is even across the top and bottom


Tumbler Block/Sashing Assembly:

For each row across, you will need to add the sashing to the Tumbler pieces as follows:

Sew sashing to RIGHT side (4 units) Sew sashing to LEFT side (4 units)

Background:

Sew sashing on RIGHT side (5 units) Sew sashing to LEFT side 9 (5 units)



This is what each finished tumbler/sashing block should look like.
